Why: JPS Health Network is celebrating its continued commitment to providing excellent health care to students and siblings in Tarrant County. The new school-based health center, which is now open in Mansfield, is expecting approximately 3,600 visits per year. The facility is available to students attending Mansfield ISD, as well as their younger siblings.

This school-based health center is the 14th for JPS. Typical services offered include treatment for sore throats and colds, immunizations, school physicals, and assessment and treatment of minor injuries. Students with no insurance pay \$5 per visit.
