JPS Health Network's Administrative Fellowship presents a unique opportunity for qualified candidates to learn and grow as healthcare professionals under the leadership and guidance of the executive team.

Founded as a teaching hospital, JPS is the nation's largest hospital-based Family Medicine Residency and Fort Worth's only Emergency Medicine Residency. The network is comprised of a 582-bed acute care hospital, inpatient behavioral health facility, and more than 25 clinics throughout Tarrant County, including an ambulatory surgical center, oncology center, pharmacies, and an HIV/AIDS health clinic. With more than 7,200 team members, JPS ranks among the area's largest employers.

The Administrative Fellowship is a one-year program that begins each June. The program is designed to develop leaders in healthcare by exposing recent graduates to a wide range of operational experiences. Fellows will spend time in division rotations learning, observing, and taking ownership of work projects.

Candidate selection and division rotations are based on the combination of organizational strategies and Fellow skill sets and interests. Who Can Apply

- Candidates who have earned an MHA, MBA (with an emphasis in healthcare management), or MPH from a CAHME, AACSB, or CEPH accredited program by the start of the fellowship. To be eligible, candidates must be recent graduates within the last 12 months of the start of the fellowship.
